1995	ICUF established to provide disaster relief to credit union members
2000	Small Credit Union Grant was established
2005	Began providing credit union educational resources alongside disaster relief
2008	Asset Building programs started to match participant savings
2013	Warren A. Morrow Memorial Scholarship fund established
2015	Sponsored "Money Smart Read" entrepreneurship education program to 800 Iowa students.
2019	First Financial Coach Training Program implemented
2020	\$700,000+ raised for COVID-19 relief
2022	Published Economic Realities of Communities of Color Statewide Report
2024	Financial Inclusion Grant program established to collaborate with community organizations to combat financial wellness barriers in Iowa
